India's vote for the post of BCCI President ends on Saturday with the ICC elections. It is likely that there will be a change of guard in India's cricket leadership with one of the most prominent faces from Indian cricket - former cricketer and commentator Ashok Mehta - joining the race. While Mehta has got the support of the Indian cricket boards of the Rajasthan and Himachal Pradesh, he has said that he will not go for the position unless he is sure of a majority. "Unless I am voted in by the cricket boards, I have no place in the election," Mehta said. He further added, "I have no idea if I will get enough votes to be elected. The support of the boards is a must because it would be an uphill task otherwise." Meanwhile, BCCI president N Srinivasan has already announced that he will not be seeking a fourth term. "I have always said that I will not seek a fourth term. But in an era where everyone is obsessed with performance, I have said I will stay away from the office," he said.
