

-w tells Exec to wait for the program to exit. You can use this option with any number of programs, but the most common usage is to create a console that waits for and then runs multiple console

programs concurrently. `-e` tells Exec to not use the system's default path to find the program. You can use this option with any number of programs, but the most common usage is to create a console that searches for and runs multiple programs concurrently. `-d dir` is the directory where the program's help and manual page files will be placed (the `-h` option creates them there). If you omit the `-d` option, Exec uses the current directory, which it looks for the `program.exe` file. Arguments may be quoted. Exec strips any leading or trailing quotation marks from the command-line arguments. If you don't want this to happen, use double quotes around the arguments.

Exec -c Option You can use the `-c` option to start a console program in a new console, instead of the current console. When you use the `-c` option, Exec will run the program as soon as it starts.

`Exec.exe -c myconsoleprog.exe MyProgram.cpp` After executing the above command, you should see a console window named `myconsoleprog`. The window title will be the program's title, but it's a console program so the title does not display the working directory. The program is also running, but the input and output windows are not displayed. This option is only meaningful when you are running a console program and you want Exec to start it running in a separate console window (as opposed to the current console window). If you intend to run a console program that processes user input, I recommend that you use the `-c` option.

`Exec.exe -c myconsoleprog.exe` After executing the above command, you should see a console window named `myconsoleprog`. The window title will be the program's title, but it's a console program so the title does not display the working directory. The program is also running, but the input and output windows are not displayed.

Exec -w Option You can use the `-w` option to wait for the program to finish. You can use this option with any number of programs, but the most common usage is

The numeric values you may use correspond to the Win32 SetWindowPos API constants. -e uses the option menu. -d configures the directory where the console program will look for the Win32

GetModuleFileName API. If you don't specify this option, Exec Crack will use the directory where the program file resides. -h shows the help screen. You can mix and match these command-line options.

For example, you can start the program in the taskbar with the -w option but with the -c option in the console window. Command-line arguments are passed to the program as-is. This means that you can include spaces and quotes in the arguments. Exec is not particularly good at error-handling. Most of the time, the program will run with no problems. However, there are a few pitfalls you may encounter. I've included a list below with some examples of how you might be able to handle each one. EXAMPLE 1: The program crashes and you don't get an error message In this example, you're starting the program as the console version, but the program crashes after

launching. You may get an error message similar to the one below:
****(no title)** **WINDOWS**** The program will now be running in the background. You should see the process's window in the taskbar and a new window in the foreground. If you click on the process in the taskbar, you'll get a similar window as if you clicked on the new process. ****LEFT-CLICK THE PROCESS IN THE TASKBAR****

If you're using Exec.exe, the -e option is only meaningful when you're running a GUI program that you want to start with a matching window frame color. -d dirname instructs Exec to run the program from a directory rather than from the current directory. -h instructs Exec to display a usage message. If you are using the GUI version of Exec, you can also use the -h option to toggle the display of the usage message. -p argv if you are using the GUI version of Exec, you can specify an arbitrary command-line to launch the program. Exec provides some optional default values for its command-line options: -c creates a console (i.e., you don't have to specify -c if you're launching a console program). -t sets the window title if you are launching a GUI program and the program's -t option was not specified. -w sets the window size if you are launching a GUI program and the program's -w option was not specified. -e sets the window color if you are launching a GUI program and the program's -e option was not specified. -d "dir" instructs Exec to run the program from a directory rather than from the current directory.

-p "[program-name-prefix...]" instructs Exec to launch the program with a particular command-line. This is only relevant for ExecGUI.exe. Exec provides the following command-line options for programs that don't specify any command-line arguments: -u :
